## MINISTER'S MESSAGE



### **WRONG MOVES**

At one time in the past I was able to play a little "chess" (emphasis on little). This game as well as others is computerized now days so if you do not have an opponent, you can play against the computer. So, I tried that.....30 seconds later I was beaten. I tried it again...same results. To say the least, I'm a little "rusty". Do you remember the last time you played a game of "checkers"? As you well know, when one is playing either one of these games he has to watch the moves that he makes on the board as a wrong move will get you beaten.

You know, the same principle is true in life. The Bible has a great deal to say about the importance of obedience to God. There are many Biblical examples that we could turn to but one stands out clearly, and that is King Saul. God gave these instructions to Saul, "Go and utterly destroy the sinners, the Amalekites and fight against them until they are exterminated." I Samuel 15:18. But instead of doing this, Saul brought back the King and allowed the people to bring back some of the sheep and oxen. To such action the prophet Samuel replied, "Has the Lord as much delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed better than the fat of rams." I Samuel 15:22. Saul learned the hard way that obedience to the will of God is the purpose of all aspects of life. Instead of keeping his eyes fixed upon God, Saul turned to human wisdom, A WRONG MOVE EVERY TIME, which resulted in his ruin.

My friend, the same is true with us. Strict obedience to God and His Will is absolutely necessary for us to be pleasing to Him. Let's be cautious of any WRONG MOVES.
