MINISTER'S MESSAGE



Sea Turtles

Over the past several weeks, more than 300 sea turtles have washed up on the beaches of Cape Cod, Massachusetts. They are attracted by the nesting grounds of the nearby Gulf of Maine. When they try to leave, they become trapped in the frigid waters of the hooked cape. It takes only a few hours for the turtles to nearly freeze solid and in most cases die. The reptiles then wash up to be found on the beaches.

This reminds us of the draw we find of the world. We see things that look good for us by our wisdom. We like the way they make us feel. They make us happy. They seem like a shelter from the harsh storms of life. But in reality, they are very dangerous for us. I am talking about relationships and situations that may not be sinful but lead us uncomfortably close to sin.

Many of us have friends or family members that we know are not great role models for our lives. We enjoy spending time with them. But we cannot condone their sinful lives and actions. Do we realize the impact their example has on us? Paul wrote, "Do not be deceived: 'Bad company ruins good morals'" (1 Cor. 15:33).

Sometimes the environments we spend time in can be destructive to the Christ-like lives we are trying to live as well. Walking into a bar may not be a sinful action in itself. But is being there tempting you into a sinful lifestyle?

Just because something isn't sinful doesn't mean it isn't dangerous. James wrote, "But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death" (James 1:14-15).

Be careful when choosing dangerous situations. Keep your eyes open. And don't end up as a frozen turtle. -Joseph
